- José Vermeersch (1922-1997) is one of the most important post-war sculptors.
- He is acclaimed internationally and exhibitions of his work were held in Mexico City, Paris, San Francisco and Amsterdam.
- Since 1969, Vermeersch started working with bronze. He developed a patina that very much leans towards the "skin" aspect he used in his ceramics.
