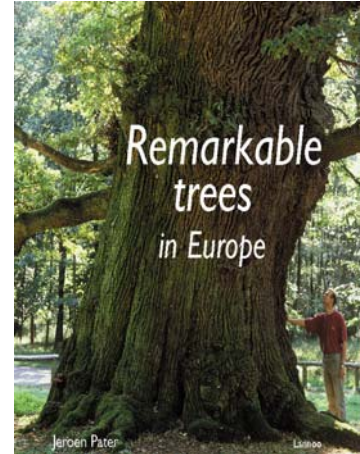


## Remarkable Trees in Europe
