Since her debut in 1987, Sylvia Vanden Heede has already written over twenty books for children and young adults. Her books have often received prizes. For her story *Wok van de Wilden*, she won a 'Boekenwelp'. *Fox and Hare*, which was published in May 1998, received an award seven times a.o. the 'Boekenleeuw' and the 'Jonge Gouden Uil'. Her book *Fox and Hare and the thief of Iek* has

recently been awarded the 'Zilveren Griffel' for the most beautiful children's book.

Thé Tjong-Khing was born in Java (Indonesia) but finished his studies in the Netherlands. He started his career as a cartoon artist, but later on he focused on children's books. Khing is now one of our most famous illustrators. He received a 'Gouden Penseel' – a prestigious award for illustrators – for his illustrations in *The dictionary of Fox and Hare*. *Where is the cake?* was awarded with a 'Woutertje Pieterse' Prize and a 'Zilveren Penseel'.
