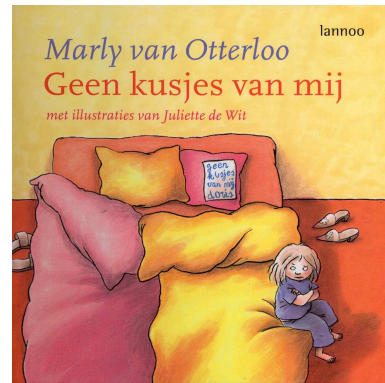


No Kisses from Me
